

Yvan Gastaut is a historian, lecturer at the Côte d'Azur University, researcher at URMIS, Unité de Recherches, Migrations et Société (Migrations and Society Research Unit), member of the advisory council of the Museu Nacional de la Història de la Immigració (National Immigration History Museum) (MNHI), and member of the scientific council of the Museu Nacional de l'Esport (National Sports Museum). His research focuses on the history of sport in relation to identity, immigration and discrimination. His publications include *Le métissage par le foot: l'intégration, mais jusqu'où?* (Miscegenation through football: integration, but how far?) (2008, Autrement publishing house) and *Who's Who?, les champions sportifs à l'épreuve des colonisations et des migrations* (Who's who? The sporting champions tested by colonisation and migration) (2019, Les Perséides publishing house). Along with other authors, he has recently directed *Une histoire mondiale de l'olympisme: 1896-2024* (A world history of Olympism: 1896-2024) (2023, Atlante-Atlantique publishing house) and *Olympisme, une histoire du monde (1896-2024)* (Olympism, a history of the world (1896-2024)) (2024, La Martinière publishing house). He is also co-editor of *Olympisme, une histoire du monde* (Olympism, a history of the world), at the Palais de la Porte Dorée in Paris.
