

Didier Grange, Honorary Archivist of the City of Geneva, is an Associate Researcher at the Centre Jean-Mabillon (ENC-PSL), Vice-President of the Association Internationale des Archives Francophones (AIAF) and a member of the SPO Steering Committee.

Involved in international cooperation for 25 years, he has held various positions within the International Council on Archives (ICA), including Vice-President, Deputy Secretary-General, Special Advisor, Secretary of CITRA and Chairman of the Section of Professional Associations (SPA). He also chaired the Steering Committee of the Portail International Archivistique Francophone (PIAF) between 2009 and 2020.

He is the author of 180 publications on archival science and has given courses in many countries.

His current research focuses on the history of contemporary archival science.
