

Stéphane Mourlane is a contemporary history lecturer at the University of Aix-Marseille (France). He is deputy director of the Mediterranean House of Human Sciences, where he coordinates the program «Territori i patrimoni de l'esport a la Regió Sud / Provence - Alpes - Côte d'Azur» (Territory and heritage of sport in the Southern Region / Provence - Alps - Côte d'Azur). His research focuses on the history of migration and the history of sport. Along with other authors, he has recently directed *Une histoire mondiale de l'olympisme, 1896-2024* (A world history of Olympism, 1896-2024) and *Olympisme, une histoire du monde* (Olympism, a history of the world). He is co-curator in two exhibitions awarded with the «Cultural Olympiad» seal: «Olympisme, une histoire monde» (Olympism, a history of the world), at the Palais de la Porte Dorée, in Paris, and «Sur la vague des Jeux» (In tune with the Games) in the Departmental Archives of the Mouths of the Rhone in Marseille.
