

Parwine Patel has held a doctorate in sciences and techniques of physical and sports activities (STAPS) (history of sports) from the University of Reunion since 2022. In addition, she holds the CAPES (External) (Certificate of Aptitude for Secondary Teaching) in English since 2016, and is currently an ATER (Temporary Teaching and Research Associate) in the English department of the University of Reunion.

Her PhD thesis focused on rugby relations between South Africa and New Zealand between 1899 and 1948. She is also the author of a book on the history of rugby on Reunion Island, which she wrote together with Dr. Tina Lauzis, and was published by Presses Universitaires Indianocéaniques (PUI) in December 2023.
