

CLUB BÀSQUET LA GARRIGA – 50 YEARS (1973-2023)

Background

The Club Bàsquet la Garriga has recently celebrated its 50th anniversary and, for this reason, it has carried out two major acts which have meant collecting, processing, classifying, describing documents (preferably the Club's event photographs and videos, but also its administrative documents) in order to produce a documentary and exhibition.

Since the Club does not have a social headquarters, this documentation is in private homes, and a communication campaign was carried out through social networks and key people at the Club who might have documentation were also visited. Research was also carried out in different archives, newspaper archives and at the Catalan Basketball Federation to retrieve press articles, match posters, federation documentation, etc.

In short, the compilation process was quite extensive, in order to document the Club's fifty years of life. And the aim of the presentation is the experience of this archival handling process and, above all, as a tool for viewing and exploiting all this documentation, which we have created at zero cost using the Office computer package, which offers a significantly reduced cost version for non-profit entities, so that it becomes the Club's digital archive.

It must be taken into account that this handling process has been carried out using the institution's own resources and by taking advantage of all the tools available to the Club, which are not those that may be available in an archive. Therefore, it is a "homemade" experience, however, we have been able to use the knowledge and experience of the president, who is an archivist by profession, to start laying the foundations for having a digitized archive of our documentary collection.

Process of handling the documentation

The process of compiling, digitalising and describing the most classic documentation was used to create a database in Excel with all the teams, players and coaches from the information that was extracted from this documentation in order to create the bases of a digital archive, not only of digitised documentation but also of exploitable data, to create a product that would allow the public to know and learn about the Club's history.

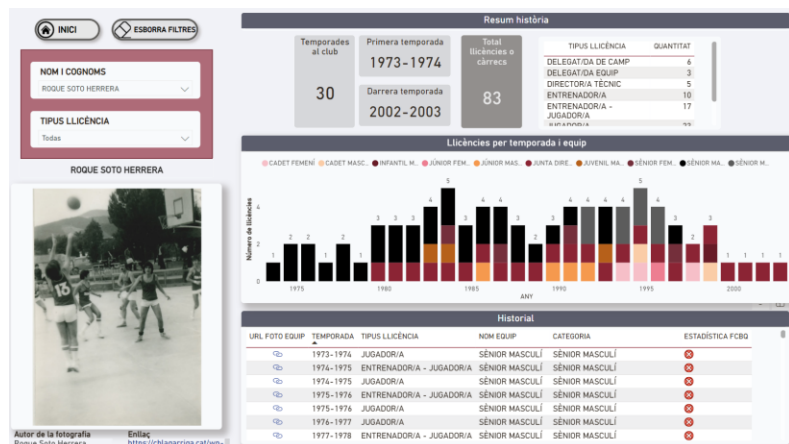
Web application of the Club's digital archive
